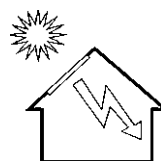


Building with PV: New product opportunities

More and more, PV is being used in energy efficient buildings for its energy efficiency, ecological benefits and aesthetical pleasing appearance.

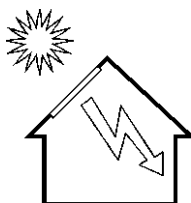
